



ICAC VISITOR PROTOCOLS

Everyone must:

1. Sign Visitor book
2. Show proof of 2 x COVID Vaccinations (3 Covid Vaccinations if Dr or Allied Health Professional)
3. Undertake a Rapid Antigen Test on the day
4. Fill in paperwork @ front admin during working hours Mon-Fri 9.00am to 4.30pm or at Village Entrance after hours
5. Wear mask and do hand sanitation
6. Have temperature taken
7. Sign out on exit

EXCEPTIONS:

Patient Transport, Emergency Services & Services that do not leave their vehicles such as Bin Collection and Taxi's can be let through gate without screening

Delivery Drivers can deliver/unload goods to ambulance bay, but are not allowed to enter internal building. They must:

- **Sign Visitor book @ Front Admin**
- **Wear a mask**
- **Sign out on exit**

Rose Mumbler Village Visits:

1. Visits to Village to be booked in with RN's only
2. All Village visits MUST be outdoors using social distancing
3. Residents can have 2 visitors (12yrs+) plus 2 children (under 12yrs) per day
4. If residents leave the Village, they must be given a Rapid Antigen Test on Day of return, Day 2 and Day 6 and monitored for any symptoms.
5. Doctors, Allied Health Professionals etc to be advised by RN re PPE and must now have 3 Covid vaccinations to enter.

Visitors must not enter Rose Mumbler Village at all if they:

- Have **COVID-19 symptoms**
- Are a household or close contact. These people must comply with the directions in the **NSW Health Household and Close Contact Guideline** and must not visit a RACF for at least 7 days after the last person in their house had a positive COVID-19 test. They should continue to avoid RACFs for an additional 7 days. If there are extenuating compassionate reasons for visiting a RACF and the visitor does not have symptoms of COVID-19, the facility may risk assess to determine whether a visit can safely occur
- Are waiting for a COVID-19 test result.
- **Have been overseas in the previous 14 days, unless they are:**
 - **Fully vaccinated against COVID-19, it has been at least 7 days after arrival and they have received a negative rapid antigen test 6 days or later after arriving in NSW.**
- People who are otherwise recently exposed to COVID-19 are recommended to not visit a RACF for at least 7 days after exposure.
